POLICIES OF THE MARLBURIAN CLUB

As agreed at the July 2011 Meeting of the Marlburian Club Committee

Club Policy for Providing 'Seed Capital' for new or inactive Affiliated Clubs

Funding from the Marlburian Club Funds may be made available for Affiliated Clubs which have become inactive and wish to restart, or new Affiliated Clubs.

The funding may be used to cover competition fees, travel costs or catering. New or inactive Affiliated Clubs should charge a reasonable subscription fee to cover their regular activities.

The Club Committee will decide, at a Committee Meeting, whether funds may be made available on the basis of merit and potential benefit to the Club and College. The Committee's decision will be final.

Club Policy for Providing Financial Support for Affiliated Clubs entering Public School Alumni Leagues

Funding from the Marlburian Club Funds may be made available for Sporting Affiliated Clubs entering Public School Alumni leagues.

The funding may be used to cover league fees, travel costs or catering. Each Affiliated Club is expected to charge a reasonable subscription fee to cover their regular activities and to demonstrate that it is able to contribute some funds towards expenses related to any Public School league they may enter.

The Club Committee will decide, at a Committee Meeting, whether funds may be made available on a case by case basis. The decision will be made after viewing the relevant financial information and on the basis of potential benefit to the Club and College. The Committee's decision will be final.
